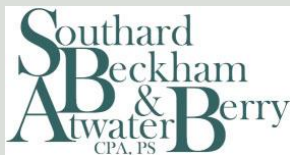

Prison Pet Partnership enriches the lives of homeless dogs, inmates and the community through the human-animal bond.

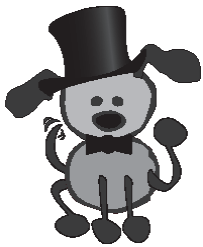

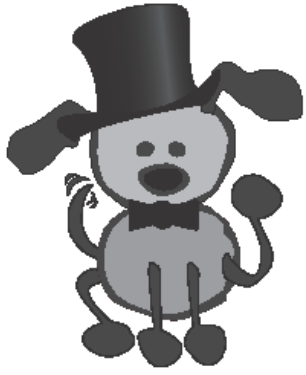
